MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS (MS)

Multiple sclerosis (MS) is a disease in which the immune system attacks the protective sheath (myelin) that covers nerves. Myelin damage disrupts communication between the brain and the rest of the body. Ultimately, the nerves themselves may deteriorate, a process that is currently irreversible.

Signs and symptoms vary widely, depending on the amount of damage and which nerves are affected. Some people with severe MS may lose the ability to walk independently or at all, while others experience long periods of remission during which they develop no new symptoms.

People with multiple sclerosis also may develop:

- Muscle stiffness or spasms
- Paralysis, typically in the legs
- Bladder and bowel control issues
- Mental changes
- Depression
- Epilepsy
